Lincoln S. Grant, 99, of 504 Hawthorne Blvd., Leesburg died March 22, 2007. He owned and operated Grant Equipment Company which specialized in the manufacture and distribution of automotive service tools and equipment from 1946 to 1973. Born in Brooklyn, NY, he was an alumnus of Georgia Tech and Beta Theta Pi Fraternity. He was a life member of the United States Power Squadrons and served as Commander of the St. Lucie River Squadron (Stuart) in 1977/79, founding member of the Leesburg Power Squadron and as president of the Hempstead, NY Rotary Club in 1960/61. He was a member of the High Twelve at Hawthorne. He and his wife, Libbie moved to Central Florida in 1993 from Port St. Lucie, FL. Survivors include his daughter, Jane Cleaveland of Atlanta, GA, three grandchildren, Diane, Grant and John L. Cleaveland Jr.; three great grandchildren and dear friends, Linda Urff and Kathleen Shields. He survived his wife of 70 years who died October 26, 2000. A Memorial Service will be held in June.
