Peg graduated Lake Forest High School in Lake Forest, Illinois in 1941. She attended Grinnell College and did graduate work at Harvard Graduate School of Education. She entered the teaching profession as a high school mathematics teacher. She taught in Connecticut and Columbus, Ohio, and then in Honolulu. Peg was given the opportunity to obtain a second Master's degree in 1959 at the University of Illinois, after which she



traveled, teaching for eleven years at the American College for Girls in Istanbul, Turkey. Peg took every opportunity to travel all over Europe, the Middle East, the Turkish provinces and Greece.

The final twenty years of Peg's teaching career were spent at the Ethel Walker School in Simsbury, Connecticut, the institution where she began. Upon retirement, Peg relocated to Florida, purchasing her home in Hawthorne in 1991.

Peg has been actively involved in numerous activities. She was an avid tennis player and participated in the activities of the Nature Club, serving both organizations as an officer. She was active in the administration of Club Hawthorne. Peg served a three year term as Director of the Hawthorne Residents Cooperative Association during 2000-2003.

Peg has played an important role in Hawthorne and she will be sorely missed.
